SURROGATE'S COURT DECISION

Queens County Surrogate's Court

Surrogate Nahman

MATTER OF JESSIE F. RICHTER, Deceased After a hearing, the Court finds that the stipulation among the parties, inter alia, denying probate to the instrument dated May 3, 1994 and agreeing to the appointment of the Public Administrator of Queens County as Administrator with Temporary Letters of Administration issuing to the Public Administrator of Queens County forthwith, is just and reasonable. Accordingly, it is approved.

Based upon the evidence adduced at the Hearing, the Court is satisfied that the will should be denied probate. Accordingly, the will is denied probate and Letters of Administration shall issue to the Public Administrator of Queens County. Temporary Letters of Administration shall issue to the Public Administrator of Queens County, forthwith.

The Petitioner is directed to turn over all the assets, books and records of the estate to the Public Administrator of Queens County, forthwith.

The Guardian ad Litem herein shall file a supplemental report within 60 days from the date of the decree to be settled hereon showing whether the decree has been complied with insofar as it affects his wards.

Settle Decree.

The Clerk of the Court is directed to mail a copy of this Decision to all parties who have appeared in this proceeding.
