SURROGATE'S COURT DECISION

Queens County Surrogate's Court

CASE

Surrogate Nahman

Estate of THERESA MANUZZA, Deceased — Unopposed petition by the Public Administrator of Queens County as Administrator for an order directing John Paul Manuzza to turn over the sum of \$53,175.09 plus interest at 9 percent from September 8, 2005 together with any additional funds which are the assets of the estate, and directing that in the event John Paul Manuzza fails to turn over said sums, that the Hanover Insurance Company of New York make such payment, is granted.

John Paul Manuzza is directed to turnover to the petitioner the sum of \$53,175.09 together with interest at 9 percent per annum from September 8, 2005 and any other assets of the Estate within 15 days of the date of the decree to be settled hereon. In the event that John Paul Manuzza fails to turn over said sums within 15 days of the date of the decree to be settled hereon, the Hanover Insurance Company of New York is directed to pay to the petitioner the sum of \$53,175.09 together with interest at 9 percent per annum from September 8, 2005 within 15 days of the date of the decree to be settled hereon.
